In 2021 the EPA revised the "Lead and Copper Rule," and all Public Water Systems are required to identify the type of material of all customer water service lines from the water main to the home/structure. We are asking you to help us identify the material your water line is made of only where it enters your home. It will most likely be Copper, Galvanized Steel, Plastic or possibly Lead.

To determine the material of your service line if you are not sure:

- A copper line will be the color of a shiny penny if you scratch it.
- A magnet will stick to a steel line, and it will be a dull gray if you scratch it.
- A plastic line will be blue, black, or white, please do not scratch it.
- A lead line will be shiny silver if you scratch it.
